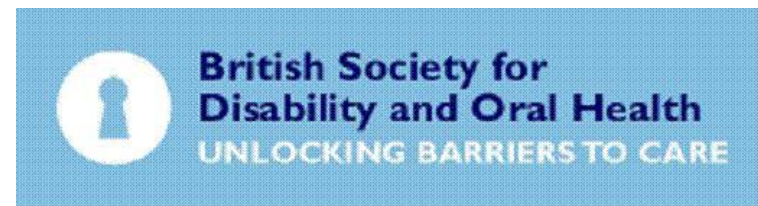

**Rail**

Kings Cross, St Pancras International and Euston mainline stations are all within 10 to 15 minute's walk from SOAS.

- **Heathrow Airport** - Heathrow Airport and Russell Square are both on the Piccadilly Line (approx. 45 mins). The Heathrow Express also runs from Paddington.
- **Gatwick Airport** - From Gatwick trains run into Victoria Station (approx. 30 mins) then take the Victoria Line to Warren Street or King's Cross.
- **London City Airport** - From City Airport take the Docklands Light Railway to Bank, from there take the Central Line to Holborn or Tottenham Court Road.
- **Stansted Airport** - Stansted Express trains go to Liverpool Street, from there take the Central Line to Holborn or Tottenham Court Road.
